


Procedure for registering in the A.I.R.E. (Registry of Italian Citizens Residing Abroad)


Key:

Italian citizens who transfer their residence from Italy to any other country or from one city to another in any country (for a period longer than three months) have an obligation, within 90 days of the transfer, to inform an Italian Consulate of the place where they reside.





BIRTHS



Italian citizens who marry abroad must declare their marital status to the Consulate of the place where the marriage was celebrated.
The marriage certificates are then sent by the Italian Consulate to the Italian City Halls for registration in the official registrars records.
Consequently the A.I.R.E. registers are updated to reflect the status change.



Births of children born (to Italian citizens) outside of Italy must be declared to the Italian Consulate of the place of birth. The birth certificates are then sent by the Italian Consulate to the Italian City Halls for registration in the official registrars records.
Consequently, the children are automatically recognized as Italian citizens and registered in the A.I.R.E.



The new consular registrations (or up dates) are sent to the Italian City Hall, of last residence, of the Italian citizen. The Italian City Halls consequently officially enter the new registrations or up dates into the Official A.I.R.E. registers (which are kept by the City Halls). Also, the Official registers are periodically synchronized with the central A.I.R.E. registers kept by the Italian Home Office.



The Italian City Halls are also responsible for keeping the electoral registers up to date, therefore even if an Italian citizen lives outside of Italy one maintains their right to vote.
NEW: As from the 6th January 2003 all Italian citizens registered in the A.I.R.E. will be able to take advantage of the law 459 of the 06.01.2001 "Vote Abroad"
