DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR THE SHIPMENT OF HUMAN OR CREMATED REMAINS

1. Passport (Italian or Canadian) or equivalent picture ID of the deceased;
2. **Certificate of Death** in original from the Provincial/Territorial Vital Statistics Agency with the **Apostille** of the Provincial/Territorial government;
3. If the deceased had acquired Canadian citizenship, a photocopy of their large-sized **Certificate of Canadian Citizenship** (front and back);
4. **Registration Photocopy of Death** in original from the Provincial/Territorial Vital Statistics Agency;
5. **Medical Certification of Death**, in photocopy;
6. **Disposition Permit and Acknowledgement of Registration of Death**, in original;
7. Payment in cash or money order (payable to the Consulate General of Italy in Vancouver) for the sum of the consular fees relative to article: 66H, 5a, 70a (see the [current Table of Consular Fees](#)).

<p>8. Declaration in original from the Office of the Chief Medical Health Officer stating that there were no infectious or communicable diseases present at the time of death;</p> <p>9. Certificate of Embalming from the Funeral Home certifying that the body was embalmed as required by Law and that the remains have been placed inside a hermetically sealed casket or metal liner;</p> <p>10. In exceptional circumstances, a photocopy of the Coroner's Certificate for Shipment may be required.</p>	<p>8. Original Cremation Certificate issued by the crematorium;</p> <p>Please note: The cremated remains must be contained in an internationally approved cremation container that meets airport security screening standards and processes. The container should also display: the first and last name of the deceased, the date of birth and date of death of the deceased.</p>

Please be advised that our Consulate General cannot request authorization from Italy until all the above listed documents have been received. Authorization can take from 7 to 10 business days.

Flight arrangements should be made only after authorization has been granted by the authorities in Italy.

Upon authorization the Consulate General will issue the certification required for travel and will contact the applicant to arrange for pick-up (or mailing at the applicant's expense).

The Consular certification must accompany the shipping container and must be available for presentation upon request during the trip to Italy.
